The FS1/FS2 broadcast schedule includes the season opener at Daytona International Speedway on Saturday, February 9 live on FS1 starting at 4:30 pm ET. Other FS1 events include races at Talladega Superspeedway on Friday, April 26, Charlotte Motor Speedway on Thursday, May 23, Michigan International Speedway on Friday, June 7, Chicagoland Speedway on Thursday, June 27, and Pocono Raceway on Friday, July 26. Two races will be broadcast on FS2, the first Pocono race on Friday, May 31 and the season finale at Kansas Speedway on Friday, October 18.

MAVTV's broadcast schedule begins with ARCA's return to Five Flags Speedway in Pensacola, Florida for the first time since 1996 on Saturday, March 9, and continues with races at Salem Speedway on Sunday, April 14, Fairgrounds Raceway Nashville on Saturday, May 4, Toledo Speedway on Sunday, May 19, Madison International Speedway on Friday, June 14, Gateway Motorsports Park on Saturday, June 22, Elko Speedway on Saturday, July 13, Iowa Speedway on Friday, July 19, the Springfield Mile on Sunday, August 18, the DuQuoin State Fair on Saturday, August 31, Salem Speedway on Saturday, September 14, and Lucas Oil Raceway on Saturday, October 5.

Dominique Van Wieringen Leads Combined Daytona Test Speeds

After two days of track activity, Amherstburg, Ontario native Dominique Van Wieringen led the combined speeds in the ARCA Menards Series test for the season-opening Lucas Oil 200 driven by General Tire.

Van Wieringen (No. 30 Rette Jones Racing Ford) turned a lap in the draft on Saturday afternoon at 49.615 seconds/181/.397 miles per hour. Her time was just 0.044 seconds quicker than World of Outlaws sprint car star David Gravel (No. 28 KBR Development Chevrolet), who times in at 49.659 seconds/181.236 miles per hour.

Neither Van Wieringen and Gravel had ever made laps at Daytona prior to the open test and both were making their Daytona debuts in preparation for the Lucas Oil 200, which both are expected to enter.

Former Daytona General Tire Pole Award winner Sean Corr timed in third overall, his fast time also coming in Saturday afternoon drafting practice. Corr (No. 8A Empire Racing Chevrolet) was just 0.061 seconds off Van Wieringen's fastest lap, coming it at 49.676 seconds/181.174 miles per hour.

The top seven speeds were set in Saturday afternoon drafting practice.

Connor Hall, eighth overall, turned his quick lap in a drafting session just before Friday's session was cut short by rain. Hall (No. 22C Chad Bryant Racing Ford), timed in at 49.711 seconds/181.046 miles per hour to lead the way in Friday's activities. Ronnie Osmer (No. 02O Our Motorsports Chevrolet) was second fastest on Friday and ninth overall with a lap at 49.754 seconds/180.890 miles per hour.

Friday morning was delayed by about 90 minutes by rain. The early part of the day was used for single-car runs, led by Riley Herbst (No. 18H Joe Gibbs Racing Toyota). Herbst's fastest lap by himself came in at 50.528 seconds/178.119 miles per hour. Herbst ended up twelfth on the overall combined results turning a lap at 49.799 seconds/180.722 miles per hour on Saturday.

Seventeen drivers turned their best lap on Friday. The remaining 30 drivers turned their best lap on Saturday.

In one of the most anticipated debuts in recent memory, Hailie Deegan will take to Daytona International Speedway's 2.5-mile tri-oval for the first time in the ARCA Menards Series Lucas Oil 200 Driven by General Tire on Saturday, February 8.

Deegan (No. 4 Monster Energy/Ford Performance Ford) is coming off her first race at Daytona, the four-hour BMW Endurance Challenge, where she drove alongside 2016 ARCA Menards Series champion Chase Briscoe to a 43rd-place finish after mechanical issues put them several laps down.

A three-time winner in the ARCA Menards Series West (formerly known as the NASCAR K&N Pro Series West), Deegan is no stranger to living in the spotlight. He father Brian is known worldwide from his success in the X-Games freestyle motocross, and her aggressive style on the racetrack only enhances the attention she receives.

"I think that I'm still developing as a

driver," Deegan said. "I'm in a development series, so there are things I'm still learning how to do. If I were perfect at everything, I'd be racing in the Cup Series. I am far from perfect, so at the end of the day I'm still learning."

The statistics and history indicate that Deegan is the first female driver to win an ARCA Menards Series West race, and the first driver to win a NASCAR touring series race since Shawna Robinson did it in 1989, whose final career NASCAR Dash Series victory came at Myrtle Beach Speedway. Robinson also holds the ARCA Menards Series record for best finish by a female driver, second, which she accomplished – coincidentally – at Daytona in 1999.

While Deegan would indeed make history on many levels should she win the Lucas Oil 200, her goal is actually quite simple. Just win.

"It's a work in progress since this is only my third year doing this," Deegan said. "I try to take what I learn from every situa-

tion and try to get better next time. I want to run all the laps and be there at the end to see what we can get."

As a rookie with no race experience in the draft, it might be easy to overlook Deegan as a contender. She insists anyone overlooking her as a threat to win is doing that at their own peril.

"To win at Daytona would be huge," Deegan said. "If there is any race I want to win this year, it's Daytona!"

Track activity for the Lucas Oil 200 Driven by General Tire starts with practice and 1:30 and 3:00 pm ET on Friday, February 7, followed by General Tire Pole Qualifying Saturday, September 8 at 12:30 pm ET. The 80-lap race will go green shortly after 4:30 pm ET; the race will be televised live on FS1 and broadcast to select affiliates of MRN Radio nationwide. Live timing & scoring of all on-track activity will be available for free at ARCARacing.com.

Michael Self Returns to Venturini Motorsports Full-time in 2020

SERIES INFO

For the 57th time in its history, the ARCA Menards Series will take to the historic highbanks of Daytona International Speedway on Saturday, February 8 in the season-opening Lucas Oil 200 Driven by General Tire.

RACE INFO

For the fourth consecutive year, Michael Self will be chasing the first checkered flag of the season. He will return to the No. 25 Sinclair Lubricants Toyota for Venturini Motorsports at Daytona looking to repeat his 2018 victory and avenge a difficult day in 2019.

TRACK HISTORY

Self, 28, from Salt Lake City, Utah, took advantage of a spate of late-race cautions and avoided several crashes in overtime to score the win in 2018. The victory enhanced his reputation as the best superspeedway racer in the ARCA Menards Series, and was a springboard to a full season with Venturini Motorsports in 2019.

2020 SEASON

Returning last year with a sense of optimism as he attempted to become the race's first repeat winner since Grant Enfinger went back-to-back in 2014 and 2015, Self found himself sliding backwards through the grass – and the air – on lap three. The damage

to his car was significant, ending his chances for victory.

“The biggest thing I learned last year is you have to be so aware and so cautious who’s around you,” Self said. “There’s so much that’s out of your control at these places and that’s what makes it so stressful.”

Self’s team, Venturini Motorsports, dominated the ARCA Menards Series season in 2019. The organization won a total of 12 races, including the Daytona race with driver Harrison Burton. Self won four times and battled teammate Christian Eckes all season long for the series championship. Eckes narrowly edged Self by just 25 points for the title.

The first item on the agenda for 2020 is to return to Daytona and click off another victory. A productive January test has Self feeling that same sense of optimism he felt in 2019.

“I was really pleased with our test overall,” Self said. “We were able to find some speed and make gains over the two days, and the biggest thing from my standpoint is that our car was very

stable in the draft. That’s extremely critical at the superspeedways.”

Self and his Kevin Reed-led team have already started working on their plan for the race but won’t really come up with their definitive strategy until the field is set in General Tire Pole Qualifying just a few short hours before the race.

“We’ll have to see how qualifying shakes out when we get there,” he said. “Then we’ll come up with a race plan of who we’d like to race around.”

Track activity for the Lucas Oil 200 Driven by General Tire starts with practice and 1:30 and 3:00 pm ET on Friday, February 7, followed by General Tire Pole Qualifying Saturday, September 8 at 12:30 pm ET. The 80-lap race will go green shortly after 4:30 pm ET; the race will be televised live on FS1 and broadcast to select affiliates of MRN Radio nationwide. World of Outlaws Star David Gravel to Make ARCA Debut at Daytona

When it comes to racing at close quarters at high speeds, David Gravel is very comfortable. After all, he regularly flies into banked corners at 140 to 150 miles per hour.

But Gravel's expertise isn't on paved short tracks or even with cars that have fenders. He does it on dirt, inches away from his closest competitors in a winged sprint car with the World of Outlaws. One of the most popular drivers in the open wheel wars as that circuit crosses the country with over 90 races annually, Gravel will be making the transition to stock car racing in 2020.

"I have an asphalt background, going back to when I was 13. The first part of my career was on asphalt, and I feel like you learn certain things at a young age that stick with you throughout your career," Gravel said. "Sprint car racing, you've got to be aggressive, but to be well rounded. You have to know when to take it easy and not take chances. I feel at my age, I've learned a lot of those things and that will benefit me to be patient and not push the envelope all the time, like staying in line at a super-speedway when we need to."

The 28-year-old Watertown, Connecticut native has collected 51 career wins over his tenure on the Outlaw tour, nearly ten percent of his starts. He'll be making the transition to stock cars with a partial season in the NASCAR Gander RV & Outdoors Truck Series, but before he does that, he'll get his



feet wet in the ARCA Menards Series Lucas Oil 200 Driven by General Tire at Daytona International Speedway.

Gravel will drive a KBR Development entry at Daytona for team owner Mike Bursley, with support from team alliance partner GMS Racing. Gravel will run six select NASCAR Gander RV and Outdoors Truck Series races for the Statesville based organization throughout 2020 but begins the season in the No. 28 KBR Chevrolet SS. Gravel impressed everyone by adapting quickly to the draft. He timed in second quick with a lap at 181.236 miles per hour.

He knows the race will be vastly different than test, with drivers being much more aggressive, but racing with aggressive drivers is something he's quite used to on the cut-throat Outlaws tour.

Gravel's career was given a boost when he caught the eye of former open wheel stand out-turned-NASCAR Cup Series champion Jeff Gordon. Now an analyst for Fox Sports, Gordon still keeps his eyes on the short track world and quickly found

Gravel to his liking. Gordon helped broker a sponsorship deal for Gravel for last year's Knoxville Nationals, and he'll be keeping a very close eye on his open wheel compatriot at Daytona.

"Jeff is going to be at the ARCA race, helping and coaching me through everything," he said.

"I'm looking forward to having him in my corner, and that will certainly give us a lot of confidence. Really couldn't ask for anybody better.

Gordon is no stranger to finding and mentoring young talent. He helped identify a young Jimmie Johnson and was instrumental in the early stock car career of the future seven-time Cup Series champion. He's looking forward to working with another young driver in Gravel.

"David was able to turn a lot of laps and seemed to feel good about the (Daytona) test," said Gordon. "He didn't get the opportunity to draft in a big pack, though. When the green flag drops, there will be a learning curve for him, but I believe he's up to the challenge."

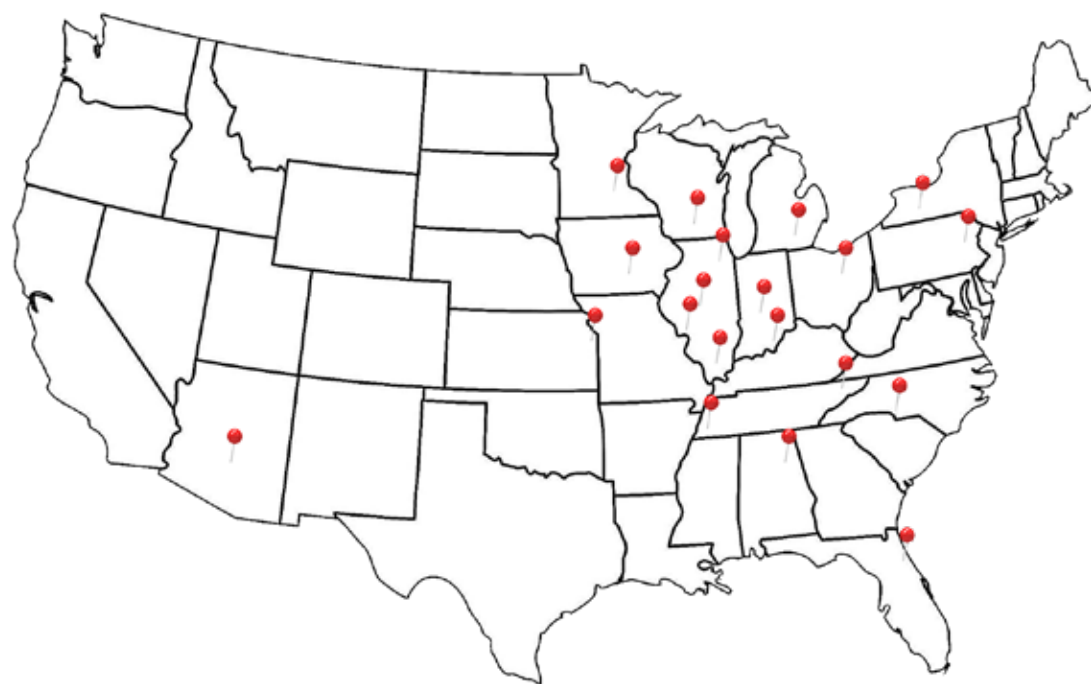

What's New in 2020

ARCA Menards Series Aligns Championship Point Structure with NASCAR National Touring Series for 2020 schedule

The ARCA Menards Series has announced a change to its championship points format, aligning the series point structure with those in the NASCAR Cup Series, NASCAR XFINITY Series, and NASCAR Gander RV & Outdoors Truck Series as well as the ARCA Menards Series East and West, formerly known as the NASCAR K&N Pro Series.

Previously, the ARCA Menards Series used a format that awarded 235 points to a race winner, 220 points for second, and then a five-point interval per position throughout the field. Five bonus points were available for winning the General Tire Pole via qualifying, for leading a lap, and leading the most laps, meaning a driver could earn a maximum of 250 points per race.

Under the new system, a race winner will earn 43 points plus a three-point bonus for winning the race for a total of 46 points, second would earn 42 points with a one-point per position interval through the remainder of the field. There will be a one-point bonus for winning the General Tire Pole via qualifying, and one-point bonuses for leading a lap and leading the most laps, meaning the maximum a driver could score by sweeping an event is 49 points.

As it has been in the past, ARCA will award teams points for competing in each five-race segment within its 20-race season. In 2020, those segments are scheduled to end at Charlotte, Lucas Oil Raceway, Watkins Glen International, and at the season finale at Kansas Speedway. Any driver

or owner attempting to compete in each of the five races per segment will earn a 50-point bonus, with any driver or owner entering and competing in all twenty races earning the maximum 200 bonus points. The same system will apply, for the first time, in the ARCA Menards Series East and West as well.

“Entering our third year as NASCAR property and now as the sanctioning body for the ARCA Menards Series East and West, we felt it was time to align our points system to fall more in line with the other national series,” said ARCA president Ron Drager. “The one-point-per-position points format has led to some great championship battles since it was implemented, and we are looking forward to seeing how it plays out in the ARCA Menards Series in 2020.”

The battle for the 2020 ARCA Menards Series championship kicks off with the Lucas Oil 200 Driven by General Tire at Daytona International Speedway on February 8. The race will be televised live on FS1 starting at 4:30 pm ET. The ARCA Menards Series East opens its season on Monday, February 10 at New Smyrna Speedway and the ARCA Menards Series West opens with the Star Nursery 150 at The Bullring at Las Vegas Motor Speedway on Thursday, February 20. Both of those races will be streamed live on TrackPass on NBC Sports Gold, and will be televised on a tape-delayed basis on NBCSN.

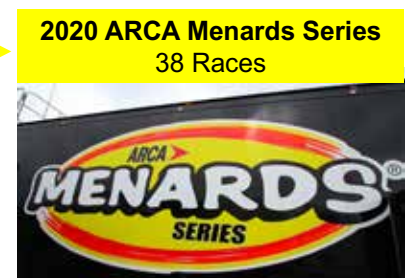
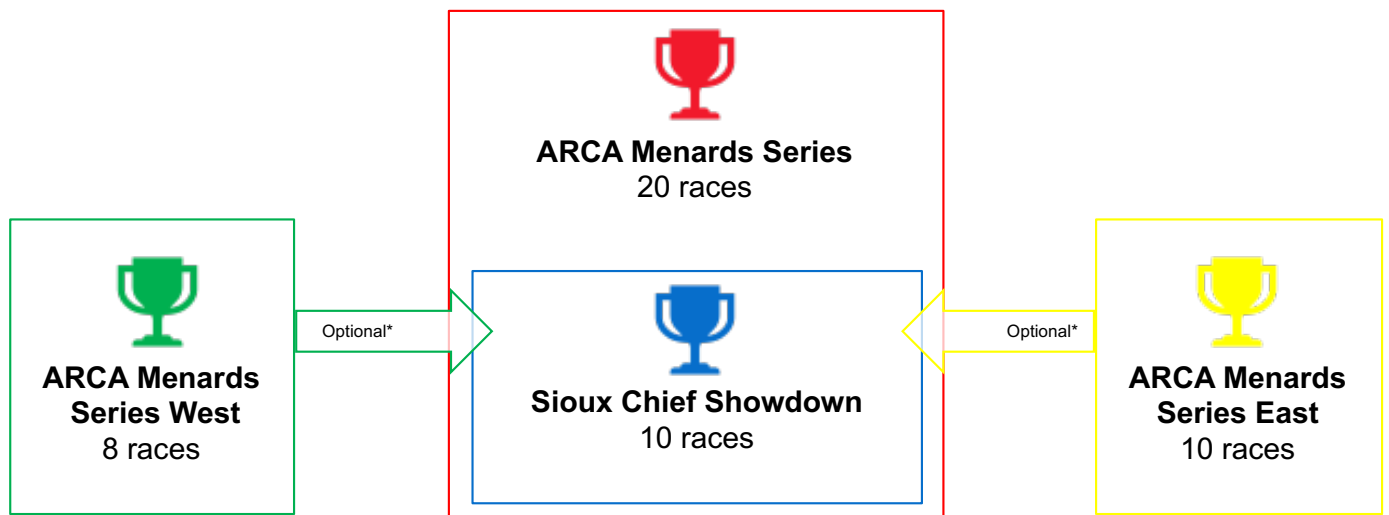

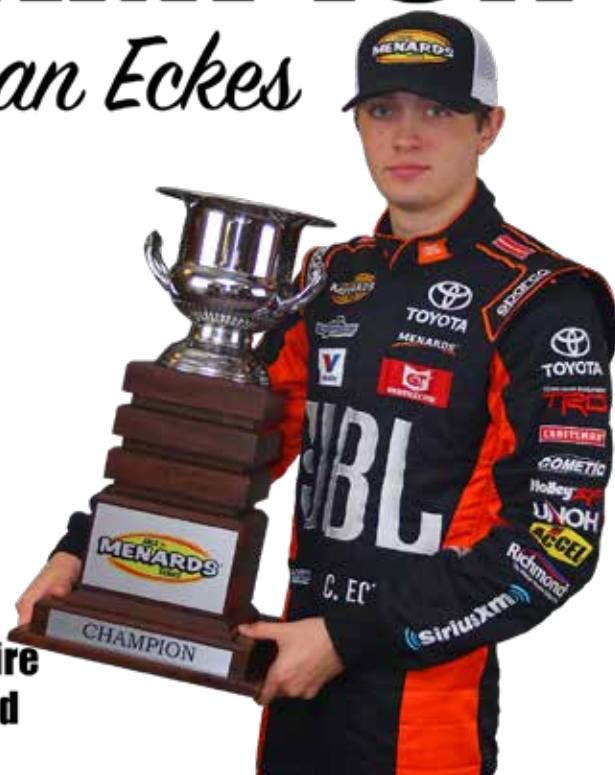
