Race Event and Year-End Awards Guide Introduction

Current January 2026

The 2026 Corporate Partners and Participating Manufacturers Contingency Program is the Series Prize Money and Decal Program, the contingency program which allows sponsors to support the drivers, team members, and car owners with per race and year end awards. The 2026 Corporate Partners and Participating Manufacturers Contingency Program rewards teams and drivers for displaying sponsor decals, and for utilizing sponsor products and services. Sponsor representation includes display of decal, and presence in victory lane, plus the opportunity to integrate components into the core of the sport.

All Posted Awards and Point Fund earnings won by any team member (driver, crew chief, etc.) shall be paid by ARCA (or Sponsoring Entity), to the registered/entered team owner via ACH transfer of funds. Any participant earning points or winning specific awards as a team member for more than one team/owner in a single season shall have all awards payable to team owner(s) based on the number of race points/awards earned per team. The team owner, and not ARCA, shall be solely responsible for the distribution of such Posted Awards to the respective team member. This shall also apply to Year-End and Point Fund Awards unless otherwise specified.

Eligibility Requirements, Owner Point Fund / Awards:

Must compete in 50% of total races to be eligible for owner point fund for respective series and must be represented at the awards celebration per Rule Book.

Tie Breakers

As outlined in the ARCA Official Rule Book, in the event of a tie in points, the tie breaker to determine position and allocation of special awards shall be determined for Owners and Drivers in the following order until tie is broken:

- Owner's Points (Applies to Special Awards Only)
- Events entered and competed in
- Most Victories
- Most top-five finishes
- Most top-ten finishes
- Most poles
- Races Led
- Laps Led
- Average finishing position
- Laps Completed

Special awards points in this category are accrued for designated events only. If a tie occurs, ARCA will use the Rule Book tie breaking formula for the designated events.

DECALS/UNIFORM LOGOS - REQUIRED FOR AWARD ELIGIBILITY: (Fender Decal Guide and Driver Uniform Guide both available as downloadable PDF at arcaracing.com/competitor-site/)

Decals must be displayed when car is brought to Inspection. Uniform Logos (**permanently affixed**) must be applied to chest, left and/or right sleeve, per the diagram. and be in place when uniform is presented for inspection. **THE COMPETITOR WILL ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR APPLICATION OF DECALS AND LOGOS TO COLLECT AWARDS.**

(Refer to the 2026 ARCA Official Rule Book for general point fund contribution payouts when sponsor awards do not reference specific dollar amounts by finishing position)

ARCA will report to sponsor companies based on application of decals and logos, and contingent use of product, regarding eligibility for award. Current valid ARCA licensing and legality must also be established.

Penalty Implications on Award Eligibility Penalties may affect award eligibility. Loss of Championship Owner Points and Driver Points due to penalties may result in loss of special awards points, and forfeiture of awards. It may also disqualify a team from a special award if victories are identifying factor in determining the award winner

Special awards paid based on performance of a driver racing for different team owners shall be paid based on the percentage of races run with the team owner

**OWNER AB PLAN PRIZE MONEY – AMS
(as listed on entry blank)**

Plan prize money will be paid to Car Owners upon entering and competing in the current season’s ARCA Menards Series events on the following conditions: “A Plan” or “Golden A Plan” prize money to each Car Owner entering and competing in 100% of the previous season’s ARCA Menards Series events. “B Plan” prize money to each Car Owner entering and competing in at least 50% but less than 100% of the previous season’s ARCA Menards Series events. AB Plan Prize Money will be increased at designated tracks. Eligibility for the AB Plan prize money based on being preregistered, present and accounted for at race events by minimum of one of Driver/Owner/Car & Transporter, as established. ARCA Menards Series transporter decal must be displayed, and ARCA Menards Series flags must be flown from top of transporter (both provided by ARCA) as required to be eligible. 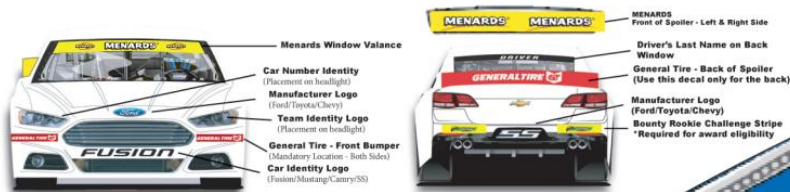
ARCA MENARDS SERIES EAST Bonus Plan:

\$7,500 ARCA Menards Series East Bonus Plan is to be paid at \$500 to any of the Top 15 eligible car owners. Eligible car owners are those who are ranked in the Top 30 of the final 2025 ARCA Menards Series East Championship car owner point standings for the first three events run, current car owner points standings after, regardless of overall finish in the event. Eligible car owner must enter the event, attempt to qualify and attempt to compete in the race. Determination of what constitutes such attempts shall be at the discretion of the Series Director.

ARCA MENARDS SERIES WEST Bonus Plan:

\$7,500 ARCA Menards Series West Bonus Plan is to be paid at \$500 to any of the Top 15 eligible car owners. Eligible car owners are those who are ranked in the Top 30 of the final 2025 ARCA Menards Series West Championship car owner point standings for the first three events run, current car owner points standings after, regardless of overall finish in the event. Eligible car owner must enter the event, attempt to qualify and attempt to compete in the race. Determination of what constitutes such attempts shall be at the discretion of Series Director.

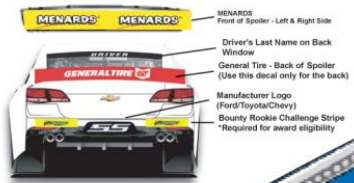
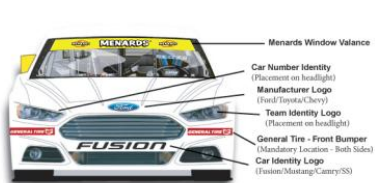

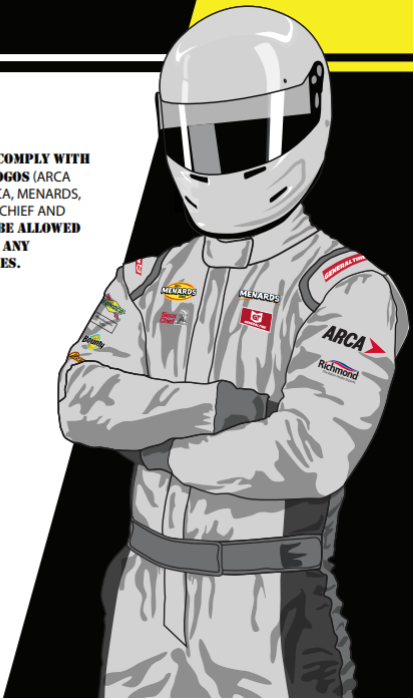

ARCA Menards Series on uppermost front left or right chest high.



MENARDS, GENERAL TIRE, and SIOUX CHIEF must be on the front chest

CREW CHIEFS: Series Logo, SUNOCO and GENERAL TIRE logo/patch required on uniform on race day.



GENERAL TIRE must be on both epaulets

CREW MEMBERS: It is highly recommended that all crew members display logos on uniform on race day.



ARCA and SUNOCO must be on the sleeves



BOUNTY, RICHMOND, and REESE'S logos required for per-race awards, special awards and point fund awards eligibility

ARCA Menards Series, East and West

1. All events \$225 cash to be paid as follows: \$100 to highest finisher, \$75 to 2nd highest finisher, \$50 to 3rd highest finisher.
2. \$4,000 cash contribution to year-end point fund. \$2,000 to ARCA Menards Series, \$1,000 each to ARCA Menards Series East and West.



Display of decals and uniform logo required for eligibility.

ARCA Menards Series

1. Bounty Rookie of the Race Award: All events, \$250 cash to the owner whose eligible driver earns the highest finishing registered rookie of the race award.
2. Bounty Rookie of the Year Award: \$10,000 cash paid to the owner whose driver accumulates the most Bounty Rookie Challenge points.

ARCA Menards Series East & West

1. Bounty Rookie of the Race Award: All events, \$250 cash to the owner whose eligible driver earns the highest finishing registered rookie of the race award.
2. Bounty Rookie of the Year Award: \$2,500 each cash paid to the owner whose driver accumulates the most Bounty Rookie Challenge points.



The CGS Imaging Four Crown provides a link to the series' roots by featuring a diverse combination of tracks in any given season. A short track, speedway, road course and dirt track are included.

CGS Imaging Four Crown Championship points will be accumulated by driver, and the year-end championship and trophy will be awarded to the driver who earns the most race points (race points only) with the highest total from the following four (must enter and compete in all 4) events:

CHEVROLET

Display of Chevrolet Bowtie and SS decal required for eligibility. Must display "Chevrolet Bowtie" logo on driver uniform. Applies to Owner's Champion.

ARCA Menards Series, East & West

1. All events cash 1st \$2,000, 2nd \$1,000 and 3rd \$750.
2. \$5,000 cash year-end Champion Owner Bonus, provided driver competes in a Chevrolet SS stock car for the entirety of the race season. Car must display "Chevrolet" designation on front and rear of car, car must display "SS" designation on front of car, and driver must display "Chevrolet Bowtie" logo on fire suit.

ARCA Menards Series

Must follow registration procedures to be eligible for "Cometic Gasket Crew Chief" honors (per race and year-end).

1. **Cometic Gasket Crew Chief of the Race:** All events \$300 cash awarded to the team owner whose crew chief demonstrates the best qualifying and race effort as determined by qualifying and race finish.
2. **Cometic Gasket Crew Chief of the Year:** \$3,500 cash year-end special award. Winner will be determined by a year-long point total based on both qualifying and finish position.
3. \$5,000 cash contribution to year end point fund.

ARCA Menards Series East & West

1. \$5,000 cash contribution to year end point fund (\$2,500 to East, \$2,500 to West).

Display of decal required for eligibility.

1. All events \$225 cash to be paid as follows: \$100 to highest finisher, \$75 to 2nd highest finisher, \$50 to 3rd highest finisher.
2. \$4,000 cash contribution to year-end point fund. \$2,000 to ARCA Menards Series, \$1,000 each to ARCA Menards Series East and West.

Display of decal required for eligibility.

1. All events \$200 cash to be paid as follows: \$100 to highest finisher, \$50 to 2nd highest finisher, \$50 to 3rd highest finisher.
2. \$3,000 cash contribution to year-end point fund. \$1,500 to ARCA Menards Series, \$750 each to ARCA Menards Series East and West.



ARCA Menards Series, East and West

Display of decal required for eligibility.

- 1) All series - \$125 cash to highest finisher.
- 2) \$3,500 cash contribution to year-end point fund, ARCA Menards only.
- 3) Product Certificates - to be paid to the Champions as follows: \$2,000 to ARCA, \$1,000 each to ARCA East & West.

SIoux CHIEF POWERPEX POLE AWARD

ARCA Menards Series, East & West

Sioux Chief will present a “Pole Award” at all events, to the driver who has earned the pole starting position.

- Display of Sioux Chief decals, and driver uniform logos required for eligibility.
- Sioux Chief will award a \$1,000 cash bonus to the owner whose driver earns the fastest qualifying position, as confirmed by ARCA, for all events in which a completed on-track competition activity sets the starting lineup per the ARCA Rulebook. No cash award, or championship points, will be awarded if an on-track competition activity does not set the starting lineup per the ARCA Rulebook. Driver / Team receiving the Sioux Chief Pole Award at all events will be credited with having earned “The Pole,” and counting towards the year end Sioux Chief Pole Award, as per below.
- \$10,000 cash year-end award to the ARCA Menards Series owner whose driver wins the most pole awards throughout the season. The cash year-end payout will be paid to the car owner, or owners, for whom the driver drove at races pole awards were won.
- \$5,000 cash year-end award for both East & West to the owner whose driver wins the most pole awards throughout the season. The cash year-end payout will be paid to the car owner, or owners, for whom the driver drove at races pole awards were won.



Sunoco 260 GTX Unleaded is the Official Fuel of the ARCA Menards Series and will be the only acceptable fuel used in competition. Sunoco 260 GTX Unleaded will be available for all ARCA Menards Series events as supplied by the authorized Sunoco representative for the event. Fuel will be tested for conformity at all events and unapproved fuel and/or additives will result in penalty. Each team must furnish approved filler cans, and each team must establish Sunoco-approved method of payment for purchasing fuel. At designated events, Sunoco will provide a maximum of 33 gallons of fuel per car in the official starting field at no cost to the team as stated on Official Tech Bulletin on Competitor Site.

1. Year-end point fund awards \$10,500 cash to be paid 1st - \$6,000, 2nd - \$3,000 and 3rd - \$1,500.
2. At designated events where no complimentary (no charge) fuel is provided to teams in the starting field. Per-race prize money awards paid to eligible car owner as specified on entry blank. 1st - \$500, 2nd - \$300, 3rd - \$200 and 4th - \$150. Must purchase 20 gallons of race fuel from approved vendor to be eligible for award.

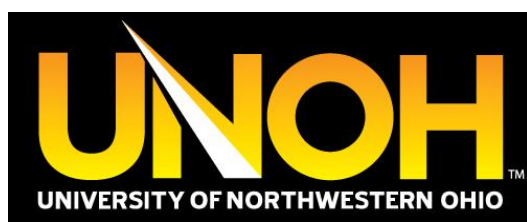

Must purchase 20 gallons of race fuel from approved vendor to be eligible for award.

Use of Toyota Camry body and advance registration and approval with Toyota Racing Development required for eligibility. If you need registered within Toyota, please email trd.contingency@toyota.com. Display of decals and driver uniform logo required.

- 1. All events \$3,750 cash paid as follows; 1st \$2,000, 2nd \$1,000, 3rd \$750 paid direct by manufacturer.
- 2. Year-End Champions Bonus - \$5,000 cash to Champion if driving a Toyota for the entire season.
